Brrr!! – Soon there will be changes in weather. Please make sure that students wear coats or jackets with hats and gloves as we go outside during the lunch recess, weather permitting. Our guidelines are: If the outside temperature is above 25 degrees with no current precipitation, we will go outside. Kindergarten through Fifth grades go out for about 15 minutes.
