Attendance and Tardies

Our school day begins at 7:45am as students enter the building. The tardy bell rings at 7:55am. Students should be in their seats ready for instruction on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. FastDirect – Grade Reports



All students in grades K to 8 receive their grades via the computer program called "FastDirect". Parents have access to students' grades daily and can also email teachers using this program. Parents who do not have access to a computer may use the school library computer or ask for a paper copy of the report card. FastDirect does not need to be downloaded to the home computer. All that is required is a user name and password, which is available by calling the school office.
